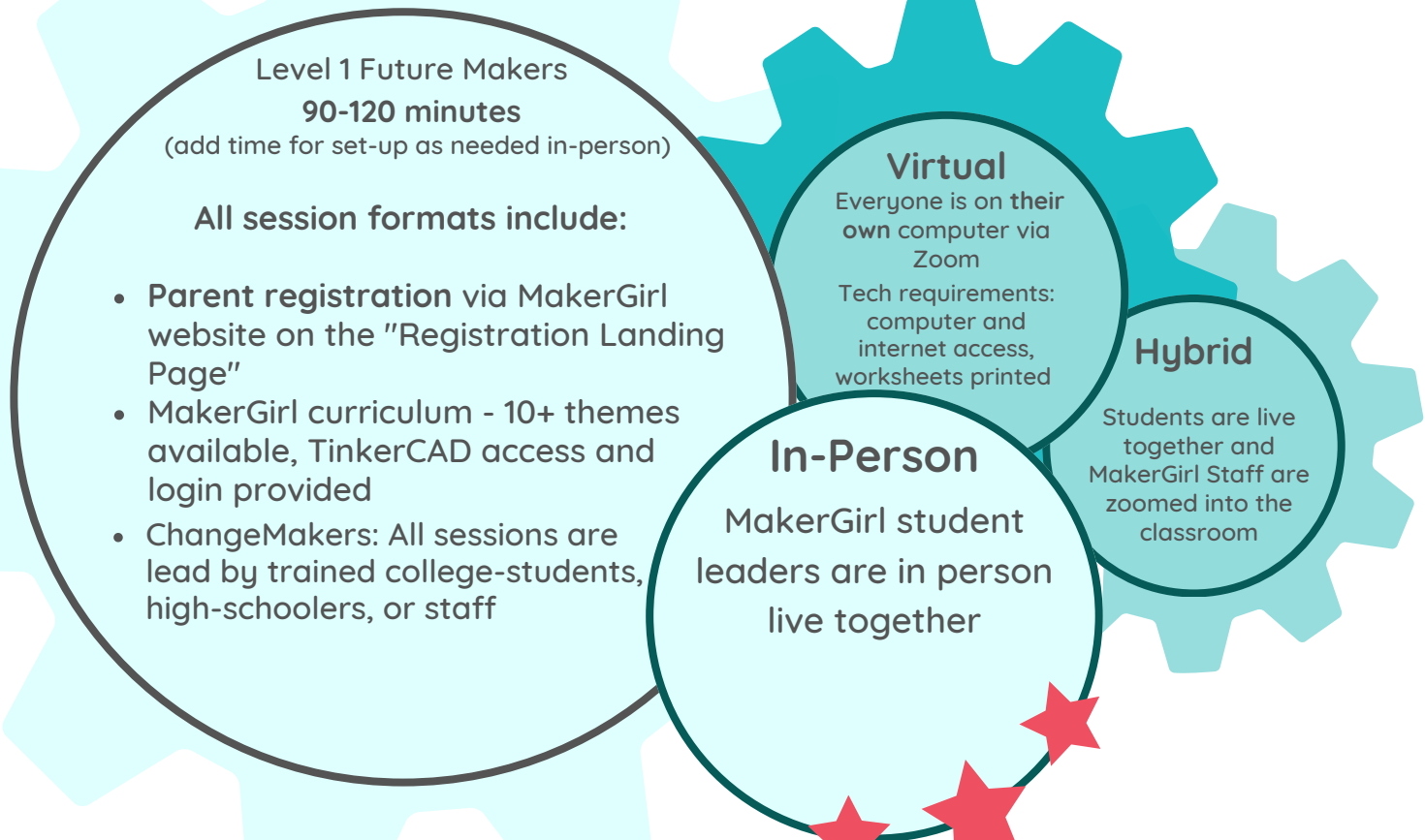


MakerGirl Level 1: Future Makers
